

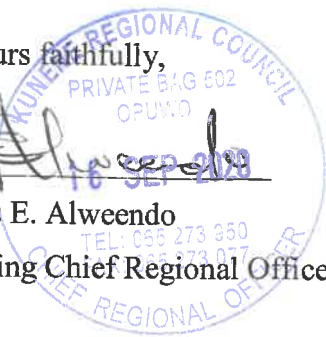

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the goods mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be **180** days from the date of bid submission deadline.

3. Delivery

Delivery shall be **14** days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted/shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

4. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

5. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Tender Box located at Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo, not later than **29 September 2020 at 11:00AM**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by fax or e-mail will not be considered.

6. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Kunene Regional Council immediately after the closing time referred to in section 5 above.

7. Evaluation of Quotations

Kunene Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

8. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a certified valid copy of company Registration Certificate;
- (b) Have an original or certified valid copy of good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) Have an original or certified valid copy good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) Have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Have a certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- (f) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;
- (h) Attach proof of confirmation of account from a Namibian Banking Institution.
- (j) Attach Certificate of Analysis (CoA) from Namibia Standard Institution containing the actual results of the products (sanitizer).
