SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council: Directorate of Education, Arts and Culture reserves the right:

- a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be **180 days** from the date of bid submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Kunene Regional Council Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502 Opuwo by the same date and time at latest 11h00. Late quotations will be rejected.** Quotations received by e-mail or fax will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted,

the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

12. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted.

Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

13. Margin of Preference

13.1 The applicable margins of preference and their application methodology are as follows:

5% margin of preference shall be given to bidders from Kunene Region.

14. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation that is not more than 0% above and not less than 15% below the engineer's estimates, with market related rates and qualified to perform the works shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

15. Performance Security

A Performance Security in the form of a Bank Guarantee representing 10% of the final contract price shall be. **Not Applicable**

16. Notification of Award and Debriefing
