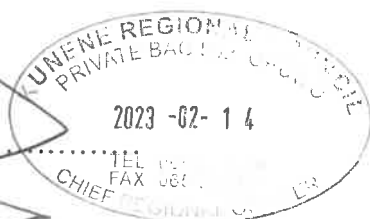

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration;
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a certified valid copy of company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have a certified valid copy of good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) have a certified valid copy of good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a certified valid copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) have a valid certified copy of certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- (f) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;
- (h) Attach proof of confirmation of account from a Namibian Banking Institution
- (i) Preference shall be given to bidders operating within Kunene Region where the goods are required. Therefore, attach a confirmation letter from the Councillor's Office (not older than two months). Furthermore, women and youth are encouraged to bid.
- i) Attach certified copy of your Identification Document (ID)

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

6. Contract Period for Services

The contract shall be on fixed rate for a period of : **to be communicated**

7. Documents to be submitted

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation documents giving company's profile, past experience and evidence of similar services provided with customers' reference details.

8. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number and addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

9. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Kunene Regional Council, Mumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo, not later than **06 March at 11h00**. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

10. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above.

11. Evaluation of Quotations

Kunene Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation.

- a) Bid prices must be market from the manufacture.
- b) Materials/goods must comply with SANS or ISO standards.
- c) Delivery schedule as per Incoterm specified in the BDS.
- d) Availability in Namibia of spare parts and after sales services for equipment offer in the bid.
- e) An adjustment equal to the cost to the Purchaser of establishing the minimum services facilities and parts inventories, as outlined in BDS, if quoted separately, shall be added to the bid price, for evaluation purposes only.
- f) Specific additional criteria.

12. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Kunene Regional Council's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

13. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

14. Margin of Preference

5% preference shall be given to local bidders (Section I: 4(i))

15. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

The bidder's price must be within 0% above and 15% below the budget allocation.

16. Performance Security

17. Notification of Award and Debriefing

Kunene Regional Council shall after award of contract, promptly inform all unsuccessful bidders in writing of the name and address of the successful bidder and the contract amount.
