1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be 180 days from the date of bid submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

Works Completion Period

The completion period for works shall be 60 days after acceptance and issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in completion period shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

5. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number W/RFQ/KRC-27/2019 and addressed to the Kunene Regional Council, Private Bag 502, Opuwo with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

6. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Kunene Regional Council Mbumbiazo Muharukua Street; Opuwo not later than 28 October 2019 at 11h00. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail /fax will not be considered.

7. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened publicly by the Kunene Regional Council at 14:30 immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of the bidder will be posted on the notice board of the Kunene Regional Council and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the opening.

8. Evaluation of Quotations

Kunene Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost to determine the lowest evaluated quotation. Bidders deemed to be responsive will be awarded subject to display of administrative compliance, obligatory documents, and equipment's listed and lowest price.

9. Technical Compliance

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

10. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted.

Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties and taxes. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.
