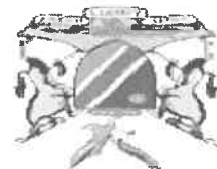



SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Security;

- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;

- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and

- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 180 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a valid certified copy (NAMPOL) of company Registration Certificate;

- (b) have a valid certified copy (NAMPOL) of good Standing Tax Certificate;

- (c) have a valid certified copy (NAMPOL) of good Standing Social Security Certificate;

(i) 5% Preferences shall be given to SME bidders operating within Kunene Region where goods are required. Therefore, attach a confirmation letter from Councillor's office (not older than two months).

Bidders are required to submit a subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The Bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation,

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be 14 days after issuing of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted as it will lead to termination of contract.

Partial deliveries are not allowed.

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations
 Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Bidder's name and contact Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

9. Opening of Quotations
 Quotations will be opened internally by the Kunene Regional Council immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted and discount offered will be posted on the website of the Public Entity.

10. Evaluation of Quotations
 The Kunene Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance
 Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, with the required specifications and to quality deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.
 The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.
