## SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

### 2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Security;
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

### 3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 180 days from the date of submission deadline.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid /certified copies of company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have an original valid or certified copy of good Standing Tax Certificate ;
- (c) have an original valid or certified copy of good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration
- (f) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof;
- (h) Have an original or certified copy of Bank account confirmation letter from a Namibian commercial banking institution.

### 5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to submit a subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The Bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation,

### 6. Delivery

Delivery shall be 15 days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery

## 7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.



## **8. Submission of Quotations**

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Tender Box located at Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo, not later than **25 November 2019 at 11h00 am**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo by the same date and time at latest 14h00 pm and Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

## **9. Opening of Quotations**

Quotations will be opened internally by the Kunene Regional Council immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the absence of a Bid Security will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

## **10. Evaluation of Quotations**

The Kunene Regional Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

## **11. Technical Compliance**

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

## **12. Prices and Currency of Payment**

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.
