General Terms and Conditions Applicable

1. Employer

- a. The Kunene Regional Council inviting the Informal Quotation is the Employer for the purpose of entering into contract with the successful bidder.

2. Service Provider

- a. The bidder having submitted the lowest price and whose offer is substantially responsive to the requirements specified shall be selected for award and referred to as the Service Provider.

3. Rights of Public Entity

- a. The Kunene Regional Council shall have the rights to
 - (a) Ask for clarifications at time of evaluating quotations and
 - (b) Reject all quotations.
- b. A Public Entity shall not be bound to accept the lowest or any quotation.

4. Eligibility Criteria

5. To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a certified valid copy (NAMPOL) of company Registration Certificate;
- (b) Have an original or certified valid copy (NAMPOL) of good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) Have an original or certified valid copy (NAMPOL) of good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) Have a valid certified copy (NAMPOL) of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Have a certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- (f) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;
- (h) Attach proof of confirmation of account from any Namibian Banking institution.
- (i) Preference shall be given to SME bidders operation within Kunene Region where the goods are required. Therefore, attach a confirmation letter from the Councillor's Office (not older than two months) or fitness certificate from the Local Authority in Kunene Region.

6. Bid Securing Declaration

7. Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation, a Bid Securing Declaration as per the format contained in Schedule 1 of this document

8. Prices

- a. Prices shall be quoted in Namibian dollars. Prices quoted shall be firm and fixed during validity period of quotation and for execution of contract.

9. The Contract

- a. The letter of Acceptance/Purchaser Order Form as the case may be together with this Informal Quotation form shall constitute the contract between the Kunene Regional Council and the Service Provider

10. Purchase Order

- a. A service provider to whom a purchase order is issued must confirm the purchase order within three days of receipt of the purchase order and;
- 11. May not change or alter the terms of the purchase order; and
- 12. must undertake to deliver the services on or before the date set in the purchase order for delivery of the services.
- 13. the purchase order shall be valid for 90days only and will be cancelled thereafter.

14. General Conditions of Contract

- a. The general terms and conditions shall be as per the General Conditions of Contract (Services) Ref. No.- NCS-LS/RFQ-GCC posted in the website of the Policy Unit and on the Notice Board.

15. Warranty

- a. The service provider warrants that the services provided shall conform to the standards, specifications as defined by the Purchaser in its Invitation for Informal Quotation subject to any alternative proposal made by the service provider in its response to the Purchaser's Invitation for Informal Quotation.

16. Payment
