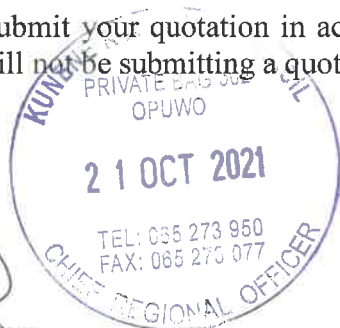

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Kunene Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Security;
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 180 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- a) have a certified valid copy of company Registration Certificate;
- b) have a certified valid copy of good Standing Tax Certificate;
- c) have a certified valid copy of good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- e) have a valid certified copy of certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- f) Submit signed bid securing declaration
- g) Attach proof of confirmation of account from a Namibian Banking institution
- h) Preference shall be given to SME bidders from Kunene Region where the goods are required. Therefore, attach a confirmation letter from the Councillor's Office (not older than two months) or fitness certificate from the Local Authority in Kunene Region.

5. Delivery

Delivery shall be **14** days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted.

6. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

7. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Tender Box located at Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo, not later than **03 November 2021 @ 11H00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Kunene Regional Council, Mbumbijazo Muharukua Street, P/Bag 502, Opuwo by the same date and time at latest 11h00. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

8. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the absence of a Bid Security will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

9. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

10. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

11. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

12. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award

of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

13. Notification of Award and Debriefing
