### PRESS RELEASE

#### FALSIFICATION OF OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS

The Kunene Regional Council has learned of the criminal activities of the falsification of Procurement Documents and signature of the Accounting Officer/Chief Regional Officer. It appears that the alleged individual identified as Moses Kamati has issued a request for Informal Quotation for Medical Patients Monitors for the Opuwo State Hospital- Directorate of Kunene Region, as the Regional Chief Officer as seen in Annexure 1 with a date stamp of 20 May 2022.

In Annexure 2, he continued to present himself as the Secretary of Procurement Chain Supply and forged the signature of the Chief Regional Officer on the "Letter of Acceptance" indicated to be an Open Standing Offer Agreement between the Kunene Regional Council and Messrs Quintessential Trading and Consultancy Pty Ltd dated June 07, June 2022. Both documents appear to have the official stamp of the Kunene Regional Council, but since the documents retrieved are a copy and not the original documents, it is yet to be determined as to how this stamp appeared on the Two (2) falsified documents as presented.

The issues has been reported to the Namibian Police and a case has been opened against the alleged perpetrator Moses Kamati. Investigations are underway to get more clarity on the matter and apprehend the perpetrator.

**The Kunene Regional Council will thus like to inform the public and distant itself from this matter as it did not issue out or approve any Request for Informal Quotations for the Supply and Delivery of Medical Patient Monitors for the Opuwo State Hospital.**

**In addition to this it is important to note that the Directorate of Health and Social Services also delegated to the Kunene Regional Council has not issued out or approved any Request for Informal Quotations for the Supply and Delivery of Medical Patient Monitors for the Opuwo State Hospital.**

The Regional Council is not aware of the intentions of the alleged perpetrator and thus would like to notify all stakeholders and public at large to be cautious in any dealings with the alleged perpetrator Moses Kamati in connection with the Supply and Delivery of Medical Patient Monitors.

The Regional Council is set to strategize on ways to avoid future incident of this nature, but meanwhile urges all stakeholders, financial institutions, service providers and the public at large to use caution of all official documents from the Kunene Regional Council, by verifying that all official communication and procurement documents should have the Signature of George P. Kamseb as the Chief Regional Officer and no one else.

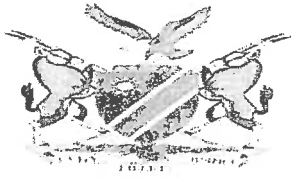

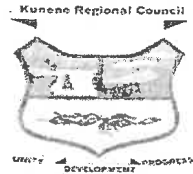
